
Big on connectivity

- The A50 provides M1 / M6 linkage
- The A42 / M42 joins the M1 at J23a
- EMDC offers a central location to Nottingham, Derby and Leicester via the A50 and A453
- The site is two miles North of East Midlands Airport, the UK's second largest freight airport
- The remainder of the site is provided with infrastructure and is ready to go
- 70% of the UK's population can be reached within two hours drive time
- Over 250,000 employees live within commuting distance of EMDC
- The new Castle Donington bypass provides direct access to the A453 / M1 / A42
