



PLANNING NOW APPROVED FOR KFC ON LONG ROW

The former Habitat building situated on Long Row in Nottingham has been unoccupied now for a number of years with several false starts for new occupiers, but we can now confirm that a letting to KFC will take place following the successful grant of Planning Permission for change of use.

KFC are due to begin fitting out on site once the landlord's works to split the unit are complete, with KFC taking circa 3,000 ft² at ground floor.
