As of February 2022, PDSA has over 111 retail shops and 48 Pet Hospitals. We have a strong covenant strength, with an average occupancy length above 18.5 years over the whole retail estate. Our retail stores also have a high quality fit throughout the building. In 2022, we acquired 10 new stores, with **30 other new** stores planned per year for the next two years alone.

New site requirements

It is essential that all of our locations have good footfall. We're a charity for people and pets, and we need to be in places that are accessible for them to be able to support us. Vehicular access to the front of the unit or the rear/ servicing is also essential to get those much needed donations into our shops.
