In addition to these anchor stores, the centre plays host to a stellar lineup of national retailers, enhancing the overall shopping experience. Names like JD Sports, Card Factory, Specsavers, Roman Originals, and Greggs contribute to the diverse retail landscape, catering to a broad spectrum of consumer preferences.



Strategically nestled within the East Midlands, Kettering enjoys a prime location facilitated by the A14 link dual carriageway. Noteworthy is the ongoing £180 million infrastructure investment set to widen the A14 to three lanes, bolstering connectivity to the east coast ports and establishing a vital link between the M1/M6 and A1M/A6.

The town's centrality becomes even more apparent with the earmarking of £20 million for highway network improvements in the town centre, a pivotal component of the East of Kettering housing development. This investment positions Kettering as an attractive prospect for commuters, benefitting from a mere 55-minute journey time and convenient half-hourly rail services to London St Pancras.

Kettering stands as a prominent market town in Northamptonshire, boasting a borough population of around 80,000 individuals and drawing from a catchment area of approximately 38,000 people within a 12-mile radius.

The confluence of enhanced transport links and the town centre's redevelopment presents abundant opportunities for Kettering's business landscape. These transformations are turning Kettering into a sought-after destination for company headquarters, warehousing facilities, and the establishment of new business parks.

Looking ahead, Kettering is poised for further growth with plans for substantial investment in cutting-edge, high-density office spaces. Leveraging Kettering's ease of access, these developments aim to meet the rising demand for contemporary workspaces in this thriving locale.

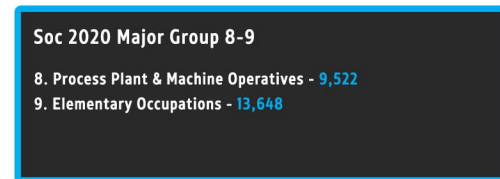
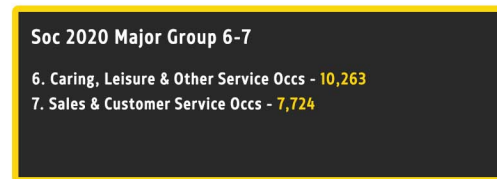
